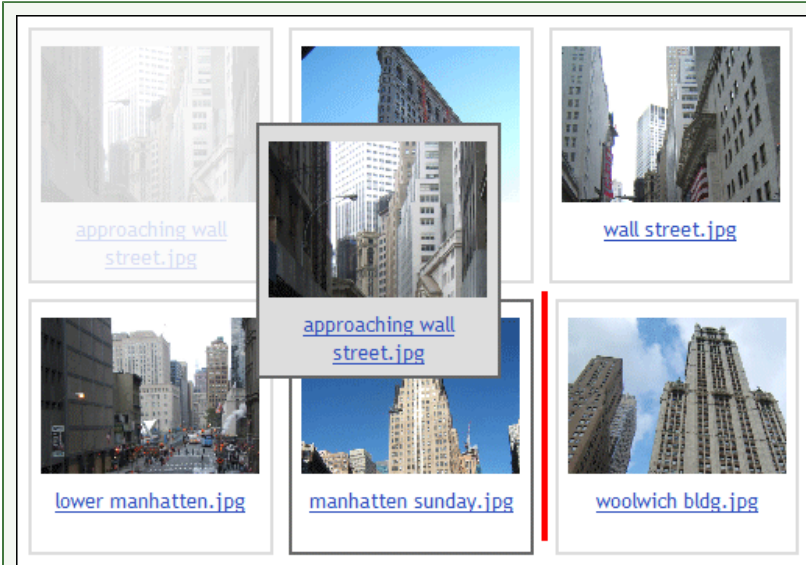


Image Reorderer

The Image Reorderer is a JavaScript-based user interface component that lets users reorder images within a collection. The Image Reorderer provides fully keyboard-accessible and mouse-based manipulation of images on-screen. It is intended to work well with screen magnifiers, low screen resolutions, and linear layouts. This component is part of the [Reorderer](#) family of components.

Note that we have changed the name of this component from "Lightbox" to Image Reorderer. You may still see references to a Lightbox. Image Reorderer and Lightbox are one and the same.
