The "tabs" classes will convert an unordered list into a set of horizontal tabs. The implementor must create the content divs and programmatically show /hide the divs in response to user input, as well as programmatically move the `fl-tabs-active` class on the currently active tab. The examples on this page are not functional in that sense, and only show one content pane.
