DIV P > #id .class INPUT[attribute=value] {  
  font-size: 1em;  
  font-color: #999;  
}
```

This whole block of code is called a CSS rule set. It is made up of multiple peices

encapsulates the entire CSS selector

encapsulates the entire CSS declaration

DIV P is a contextual selector

> is a parent-child selector

#id is an ID selector

.class is a class name selector

[attribute=value] is an attribute selector

font-size: 1em; is the CSS rule
